PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

I am very happy to report that things are really happening across the country—truly a year of challenge and change. We are achieving a positive annual growth of our national membership, re-evaluating and modernizing our national website, increasing communications with our clubs and setting the groundwork to further enhance the membership experience within PROBUS.

Six New Clubs and More on the Way

We have only two ways to grow the national membership – through the establishment of additional clubs and the indigenous growth of existing clubs. A recent marketing analysis has concluded that we require an annual growth rate of 2.5

- 3.5 % to be, sustainable. In 2017 we achieved a national annual membership growth rate of 5.1%. Six new clubs were added − Cobequid NS, Burlington, ON, Fenelon Falls, ON, Grand Prairie, AB, 4 Seasons (Collingwood) ON and Sheridan (Oakville), ON. In the first quarter of this year two additional clubs were added − East York, ON and Maple Ridge, B.C. Several more clubs are in the early incubation stage of development. We now have over 36,000 members. Congratulations to the many creative PROBUS leaders who are making this happen.

National Website Development

We have had a number of suggestions from the various clubs to evaluate and modernize the national website. Vice President Bob Boone is heading up a Steering Committee to include fellow PROBUS members Bob Ashdown, John Draper. Paul Leduc and Perry Broker, all experienced in website design to assess and coordinate the redevelopment of the site. This group will develop an Action Plan for Board approval and implementation. More on this later as the plan is finalized and put in place.

Communication with the Membership

It is essential that we stimulate more effective communication and interaction among the clubs and between the national and local clubs. To this end the District Directors are encouraging and organizing district and regional one day management conferences across Canada to share success stories within the clubs and to address many of the common challenges such as management succession, development of local websites, membership recruitment, electronic payment systems, new club development and expectations from PROBUS Canada. Check with your club management members as to what is being planned within your District.

Enhancing the Membership Experience

PROBUS is built on the pillars of fellowship (social contact), keeping abreast of the times (speakers) and participation (activities and leadership). Both the local club management teams and the national Board of Directors are pursuing the same mission. To continue with sustainable growth we need your ideas for improvement and your active participation at all levels of PROBUS.

Nominations & Elections - Board of Directors PROBUS CANADA


