

#### PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Hello fellow PROBUS Members! It is truly an honour for me to serve as the President of PROBUS CANADA for the next year. I feel like I am a member of all 245 PROBUS clubs. Let me tell you a little bit about myself and how I joined PROBUS. I was born in Montreal and lived there until I was 19 except for 5 years during the 2<sup>nd</sup> WW when we lived in Winnipeg. I was in my second year in College in Montreal, when my Dad, who was from New Brunswick, was transferred to St. Mary's, Ontario, and a town of about 4,500. This was a great move for my mother as most of her family lived in Southern Ontario. #### JOHN R. MORRIS AWARD

The John R. Morris Founders Award was established to recognize major contributors toward the ongoing development of PROBUS in Canada. It is the highest honor which can be bestowed upon individual Members of PROBUS and recognizes truly outstanding contributions toward our successful and sustained activity in keeping with our primary objectives. Following a nomination by the PROBUS Club of Shediac Shores, with support from the PROBUS Club of Greater Moncton and the Women's PROBUS Club of South East New Brunswick, a presentation of the Award to Steve Campbell, Founding President of the PROBUS Club of Shediac Shores as well as a Past President of the PROBUS Club of Greater Moncton and a Past President of PROBUS Canada, was approved by the Board of Directors of PROBUS Canada.


